

TOOLS FUNCTIONS



Select / Pan:

- These functions allow customers to select and move items within the mapping window or to shift the map imagery.
- The Select function also turns off any current mode you may be in (i.e. measure tool).

Query:

- This function allows the customer to click on a boundary to see information about the field. An information bubble will appear. Clicking on Select takes you out of the query mode.

Measure Tool:

- Allows the customer to measure a straight line or dynamic distance across or around the perimeter of fields. The distance will appear in the lower right corner of the screen. Clicking on Select takes you out of the measure tool mode.
- Print manager allows customization of zoom level, field labels, Lat-Lon coordinates, boundary outline or fill, text color, entry of field notes.
- Report includes field imagery, grower-farm-field name, acres, Lat-Lon, county-township-section, attributes.

Set As Start:

- Allows the customer bring in a specific area of the map (town, farm) and set that as the default view when I.F.A.R.M. opens.

Go To:

- Allows the customer to search for specific locations in the map by: (1). Address or zip code (2). PLSS (3). Lat-Lon (Minutes) (4). Lat-Lon (Decimals)
- The map will change / zoom to designated destination.

Boundary Mode / Field Attributes:

- Activates the mapping tools to modify boundaries in the mapping window.
- See the Map Tab function for more details on the Boundary / Attribute tools.
